S.I. 86 of 2020**COCO-DE-MER (MANAGEMENT) DECREE***(Cap 37)***Coco-de-Mer (Restriction on the Processing, Trade and
Export of unprocessed kernel of mature nut)
Regulations, 2020**

WHEREAS, the Coco-de-Mer (Restriction on the Processing, Trade and Export of unprocessed kernel of mature nut) Regulations, 2019 was published as S. I. 58 of 2019 in the *Gazette* dated 4th October, 2019;

AND, WHEREAS the National Assembly in its session on the 15th October, 2019 considered S.I. 58 of 2019 and annulled it with instructions to the Minister to reissue the regulation with certain modifications;

NOW, THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 48 of the Coco-de-Mer (Management) Decree, the Minister responsible for Environment makes the following regulations —

1. These regulations may be cited as the Coco-de-Mer (Restriction on the Processing, Trade and Export of unprocessed kernel of mature nut) Regulations, 2020.

Citation

2. In these regulations, unless the context otherwise requires —

Interpretation

“kernel” means the whole or part of the white meat (endosperm) found inside the mature nut;

“mature nut” shall have the meaning assigned to it in the Coco-De- Mer (Management) Decree (Cap 37);

“Minister” means the Minister responsible for environment;

“processed” means any alteration or a combination of mechanical, chemical or physical alteration of the kernel from its natural state, into a commercial product”;

“trade” means to buy, sell or exchange processed kernel of a mature nut;

“unprocessed” means the state of not being processed.

Restriction on

3. The exportation of any form of unprocessed kernel of a mature nut is hereby restricted.

Process, trade
and export of
coco-de-mer
kernel without
permit

4.(1) No person shall process, trade and export the kernel of a mature nut without a valid permit issued by the Minister.

(2) A permit to process, trade and export the kernel of a mature nut under subregulation (1) shall be as set out in Form II provided under the First Schedule.

(3) The procedure for obtaining a permit to process, trade and export the kernel of a mature nut under subregulation (1) shall be as set out in the Second Schedule.

(4) Notwithstanding subregulation (3) and subregulation (2) a permit may be issued for the exportation of unprocessed kernel for scientific, diplomatic and any other justified purpose.

Selection
Committee

5.(1) The Minister, in consultation with the relevant organisations, shall set up a Selection Committee.

(2) The Selection Committee shall assess the request for permit and decide whether a permit shall be issued or not.

(3) The Selection Committee shall consist of —

- (a) a representative of the Ministry responsible for Environment;
- (b) a representative of the Ministry responsible for Trade;
- (c) a representative of the Civil Society;
- (d) a representative of the National Institute of Science, Technology and Innovation; and
- (e) an expert in the field of conservation.

(4) One of the Members of the Committee shall be appointed as Chairperson and three members shall constitute a quorum.

(5) The Terms of Reference that will guide the work of the Selection Committee shall be agreed upon at the first meeting of the Committee.

(6) The Term of Reference shall include a review of the stock of mature Coco-de-Mer nuts and a review of previous requests and permits granted under these regulations.

(7) The decision of the Selection Committee shall be communicated to the applicant, in writing, within 7 days of the decision and a copy thereof shall be sent to the Minister for information.

6.(1) Any person aggrieved by the decision of the Selection Committee may, within 14 days of the receipt of the decision, submit a written appeal to the Minister. Appeal

(2) The Minister, in consultation with relevant organisations, shall constitute an ad-hoc Appeals Committee to assist the Minister in hearing or deciding an appeal.

(3) The Appeals Committee shall consist of —

- (a) a representative of the Department of Legal Affairs who shall be the Chairperson;
- (b) a representative of the Ministry responsible for environment; and
- (c) an expert relevant to the subject matter appealed against.

(4) The Appeals Committee shall assess the merit of the appeal and within 30 days convey its recommendation to the Minister, on whether to confirm, vary or quash the decision of the Selection Committee.

7.(1) The Minister shall, on receipt of the recommendation of the Appeals Committee, confirm, vary or quash the decision of the Selection Committee.

(2) The Minister shall communicate, in writing, the decision taken under subregulation (1) to the aggrieved person within 7 days of receipt of the recommendation of the Appeals Committee.

Offence and
penalty

8. A person who contravenes regulation 4 shall be guilty of an offence and on conviction shall be liable to a fine not exceeding SCR20,000 or to imprisonment for 2 years or to both such fine and imprisonment.

PROCEDURE TO OBTAIN PERMIT TO PROCESS, TRADE AND EXPORT KERNEL OF A MATURE NUT

(Regulation 4)

1. The Ministry shall invite application from interested individuals who wish to obtain a permit to process, trade and export kernel of a mature nut.
2. The invitation of application shall be published in a local newspaper for 3 consecutive weeks.
3. A person interested in obtaining a permit shall apply to the Ministry in Form I provided under the First Schedule.
4. The Selection Committee set up under regulation 5 shall take action on the applications received and prepare a list of eligible applicants.
5. All eligible applicants shall be informed, in writing, within 30 days after the last publication of invitation.
6. Invitation of application shall be made every 2 years.
