ANACT to alter the Constitution.

ENACTED by the President and the National Assembly.

- **1.**(1) This Act may be cited as the Constitution of the Short title Republic of Seychelles (Seventh Amendment) Act, 2016.
- (2) This Act shall come into operation on such date as the President may, by notice in the Gazette, appoint.

Amendment of Cap 42 as last amended by Act 7 of 2011

- The Constitution of the Republic of Seychelles is 2. amended as follows —
 - (a) in Article 52, by repealing in clause (2) the word "three" and substituting therefor the word "two";
 - in Article 52A., by repealing in clause (2) the words "or second";
 - in Article 66A,
 - by repealing in clause (7) the words "3 terms" and substituting therefor the words "2 terms;
 - (ii) by repealing in clause (12) the words "2 other terms" and substituting therefor the words "1 more term".
