1. Citation

This Order may be cited as the Road Transport (Closing of La Poudriere Road (West) to Vehicular Traffic) Order.

2. Closing of La Poudriere Road (West)

- (1) Except for access to or exit from State House, no vehicle shall be used on La Poudriere Road between the entrance to State House and Bel Air Road.
- (2) The exact points within which the use of the road is prohibited by this Order shall be indicated by signs erected under section 19(1) of the Act.
