Employment Act (Fixed-term Contract)(Exemption) Regulations

The Regulations may be cited as the Employment Act (Fixed-term Contract) (Exemption) Regulations.

2.

A fixed-term contract in respect of a worker or class of workers specified in the Schedule is exempt from the application of section 19(2).

Schedule

1. A non-Seychellois worker
2. A Seychellois worker performing the functions of, or functions equivalent to the function of, Chief executive officer of a public body;
3. A Seychellois worker performing the functions of an office in respect of which the holder is entitled to at least a basic salary equivalent to entry point 48 in the Public Service.
